THE PROBLEM

Notwithstanding the commitment in the Universal Basic Education Act to free and compulsory basic education for all children in Nigeria, UNESCO estimates that over 10.5 million children in Nigeria do not have access to education.

The World Bank in its May 2013 Nigeria Economic Report notes that poverty rates remain high in Nigeria (112 million Nigerians representing 67% of the population), particularly in rural areas.

OUR SOLUTION

Bedrock Human Development Foundation aims to provide scholarships to underprivileged and deserving secondary school and university students. The Foundation also recognizes that many disadvantaged youths in rural communities who missed the opportunity to acquire an education also lack skills that would enable them gain meaningful employment.

To this end, we aim to provide access to skills acquisition and medical programme for disadvantaged youth under our Rural Aid Initiative.

WIDOWS OUTREACH AT HOME OF GOD'S GRACE ORPHANAGE & WIDOWS

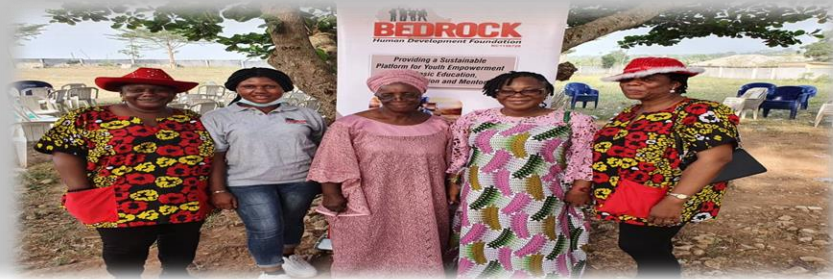

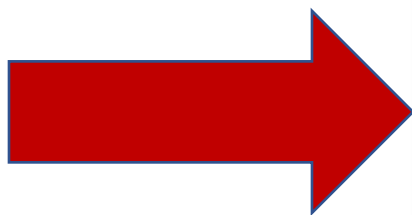
My name is Omorogieva Osasere Blessing. I am from Edo State, Benin City.
